We wish to strongly protest about your plans for a new housing development adjacent to Peulwys Lane in Old Colwyn.

When we came to Old Colwyn fourteen years ago it was a pleasant village. It is now equivalent to a large town, choked by traffic and uncomfortably full of people. My partner and I find it increasingly difficult to get appointments at our health centre, and the bus service has become increasingly irregular with sometimes a wait of over half an hour before any bus turns up. When it does the bus is often over packed with passengers, with old people like my partner and myself having to stand for long periods.

Has anyone actually checked the traffic pollution levels in the village?

We note that Extinction Rebellion has written to Gwynedd County Council telling the authority they wish to "highlight the car centred transport infrastructure of the county." This applies equally to Conwy County Council as well, and we shall be inviting Extinction Rebellion to make a similar representation to you.

How can you come up with this plan for development when Climate Change is roaring out of control? This is not to mention the beautiful country which we use to walk in which will be destroyed if the plan goes ahead, nor the destruction of habitat of many animals, birds or insects.

Old Colwyn has a beautiful beach and beautiful hill walks, and could attract many visitors, with all the associated revenues. This will not happen if the village is clogged with traffic. This is a seaside village, not a major city!

We are prepared to protest to save our village, and will not be treated with contempt, as some of us were at the meeting at Sure Hope Church recently.
