Summary Comment (maximum 100 words): Pressure of extern traffic on Reubyshare, Monetian Road and Caed Coch Road in Old Calwyn . See attached sheet ,

My comments refer to the increase in traffic which will occur when the proposed residenal development off Realyshene Old Colunger mill be built. Traffic from the Paulings Form site will it seems enter Peulys have at the new sunction and then go down either Coed Coch Road or Wanetion Road of they are going to Calwyn Bay, to soin the A55 or heading any where in a general easterly or westerly diviction. This traffic mill fund down to the roundabout at the Marine Hotel which as anyone who lines in Old Colwyn Arrows is a chaotic place at "rush hour" times and when the schools are opening / closing. Coed Coch rood, from its start off totan Abergele Rood to its end at its junction with Peulings have is effectively a one way struct due to partial cars. The lower end of Wonetion Road to the Marine Roundabout is also very congested due to portred cars at most times, the situation often becoming dangerously chootic when the schools open and close. In short, traffic in the orea has got to the stage where the roods, designed when shere were few cars on the rood, are becoming overwhelmed. This should be obvious to any planner and taken into account when development of sites are token into consideration.

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
