Further to the above please note the following comment made on behalf of CEMEX UK Operations Ltd.: -

• Background Paper BP37 needs to go much further than simply avoiding the sterilisation of aggregate resources. The paper should provide background information regards ensuring the sustainable management of minerals resources to meet the Council's growth aspirations in terms of social, economic and environmental considerations. As mentioned in the Consultation Paper the Council is required to ensure an adequate supply of minerals is maintained. This must be done to accord with PPWv10, the RTS and using such information as the AM Surveys and the documentation produced by the NWRAWP. There is also an element of confusion arising from the notion that terms such as "aggregate" and "minerals" and also "reserves" and resources are interchangeable.

It is noted that the proposed Background Paper is scheduled for release in Summer 2019 and CEMEX would welcome the opportunity to discuss this as a draft with Council officers if this would be of assistance.
