I am an owner occupied at 15 Gwellyn Avenue Kinmel Bay and would like to make the following comments in relation to the new LDP for the County Of Conwy;

1) Flooding Planning Restrictions - I would like to see Sea Defences strengthened on Kinmel Bay Promenade in view of global warming. I would also like to see River Clwyd West Bank strengthened.
